SECOND BACCALAURETE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the second baccalaureate degree program is subject to approval by the chairperson of the department and dean of the school in which the degree is being sought.

Students who wish to obtain a second baccalaureate degree from Jackson State University must meet the following criteria:

1. Gain admission to the University.
2. Declare intent to pursue second baccalaureate degree by completing the Application for a Second Baccalaureate Degree. The Application for a Second Baccalaureate Degree may be secure from the Office of Admissions and Recruitment or from the office of the school dean.
3. Develop degree plan with approval of an advisor from the department in which the degree is offered.
4. Complete at least 30 semester hours of approved courses beyond the first baccalaureate degree in residence at Jackson State University.
5. Maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.00.
