The *ADA Technology Advisory Task Force* has been designed to assist the *Office of Support Services for Students and Employees with Disabilities* with evaluating and fostering favorable compliancy efforts regarding *technology* designated for persons with disabilities within JSU. It falls under the auspices of The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Coordinator, and is not limited to but serves in the following capacity:

- 1) Promotes awareness regarding the issue of providing services and interacting with persons with disabilities
- 2) Serves as a catalyst for getting persons throughout the university involved in compliancy relevant to applicable mandates, i.e., ADA, Section 504 and 508 of the Rehabilitative Act of 1973
- 3) Utilizes applicable campus resources relevant to specific areas of compliancy for the best results, i.e., The ADA Technology Task Force could involve representatives from areas such as: Information Technology, Computer Engineering, Telecommunications Engineering, Technology Education, and Psychometric Services
- 4) Offers university students and personnel an opportunity to utilize their attributes in being a part of making the campus accessible for all persons that matriculate
- 5) Offers interested persons an opportunity to give input to the process and actively get involved in approved university efforts that promotes compliancy
- 6) Offers committed persons an opportunity to do volunteer service to help Jackson State University help others

The *Authentication Effort* for potential *Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Technology Advisory Task Force members* involves but is not limited to the following:

- 1) Must successfully complete an informal as well as official interview with the ADA Coordinator, and
- 2) Must successfully complete a formal ADA Sensitivity/Awareness Training Session as set forth by the Office of Support Services for Students and Employees with Disabilities, and
- 3) Encouraged to participate in activities coordinated by their said *ADA Technology Advisory Tasks Force*, and
- 4) Must be open to having a genuine concern for persons with disabilities as well as those persons affiliated with the university in general
