The ETS Major Field Test in Business (MFTB) assesses a student's mastery of concepts, principles, and knowledge in the common core which includes accounting, economics, finance, business law, management, marketing, information systems, statistics and analysis, supply chain management, and international business issues. The MFTB contains 120 multiple-choice questions designed to measure a student's subject knowledge and the ability to apply facts, concepts, theories and analytical methods. Some questions are grouped in sets and based on diagrams, charts and data tables. The score for the MFTB is reported on a scale of 120-200.

In the College of Business, the MFTB will count as a test score in the MNGT 458 course. Please see the course requirements and grading scale for MNGT 458 below with the *MFTB section highlighted. Points for the MFTB will be based on the overall student score. As can be observed, the student's grade for the MFTB depends on his/her total test score.
