2016-2017 GUIDE TO ACADEMIC ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS

Overview

A limited number of academic scholarship awards are available to students who have demonstrated the potential to successfully matriculate into our Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, and Telecommunications Engineering programs. Students pursuing any other major are ineligible for these scholarships. All scholarship recipients must be continuously enrolled full-time in one of the three aforementioned majors at Jackson State University, and recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of at least 3.0 for continued eligibility. Must not have any other tuition scholarships. Scholarships are renewable, upon reapplication.

Eligibility Requirements - Entering Freshmen

- Applicants must have completed high school by Fall 2016 and meet all entrance requirements for the University.
- No other tuition Scholarships (ex. you are receiving funds that covers your tuition)
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.00 or higher on a 4.00 grading scale;
- Minimum ACT composite score of 21 or higher (or SAT: 990 critical reading + math);
- Completion of two units of high school algebra, one unit of geometry, and one unit of trigonometry;
- Completion of one unit of chemistry and one unit of high school physics.
- Submit a statement letter
- MUST BE U.S. CITIZEN OR PERMANENT RESIDENT

Eligibility Requirements - Transfer Students

- Applicants must meet all entrance requirements for the University.
- Entering Junior/Community College or other transfer students must have a minimum GPA 3.25 on a 4.00 grading
- Preference will be given to applicants who have completed College Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus, Chemistry, and Physics.
- No other tuition Scholarships, submit a statement letter
- MUST BE U.S. CITIZEN OR PERMANENT RESIDENT

 - 1. Completed Engineering Scholarship Application form
 - 2. Official copy of high school or college transcript(s)
 - 3. H.S. students should also submit a letter of recommendation from a member of the high school mathematics or science faculty.
- CSET scholarship committee will review all applications

Application Deadlines

Applicants who plan to enroll in Fall 2016 must file an application by May 16, 2016.
