<u>Master of Science</u> <u>Community Counseling Concentration</u>

Admission Requirements

Applicants must be admitted to both the Graduate School and the Guidance program. The Counseling Program has the following admission requirements in addition to the Graduate School requirements.

- 1. A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 for regular admission and 2.80 for conditional admission, at the undergraduate level.
- 2. A satisfactory score on the GRE within the last five years, sent directly to the department.
- 3. Personal interview and a writing sample.
- 4. Three letters of reference sent directly to the department.
- 5. Applications will only be accepted for Fall enrollment . The application deadline is March 1 for Fall admission.
- 6. Successful applicants to the M.S. Ed. Programs must be certified at the "A" level or above.

Degree Requirements

To qualify for a masters degree in the department, a student must complete 48 to 60 semester hours with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above and obtain a passing score on the Graduate Comprehensive Examination.
