"Cruising the Community" fulfills our civic engagement objective by leveraging the built environment to improve our community. In 2009, Jackson State University built a walking and biking trail on the Dr. Robert Smith Parkway and the Center for University-Based Development helps promote its usage through its annual "Cruising the Community" event.

"Cruising the Community" is a one to three mile ride around the JSU campus. The event is for children ages 0-12 years old and children can ride anything on wheels including bikes, scooters, wagons, tricycles, skates, roller blades, wheel chairs, and skateboards.

The benefits of this ride include:

- •Exposing youth to safe routes for biking and walking.
- •Raising awareness about bike safety and helmet safety.
- •Providing parents and caregivers the opportunity to get free health screenings.
