The ACT Residual Assessment is administered to prospective or currently enrolled Jackson State University students. It is administered multiple times per year at the University with the stipulation that the scores can only be used at the University. A four year report containing select statistics (Mean, N, StdDev) is presented in the table above. It can be seen that the mean composite score was 16 for all years with the exception of 2011 when it was 15. Mean subscores ranged from a low of 13 to a high of 16. More students (110) took the test in 2014 than any other year.
