Jackson State University College of Lifelong Learning Assistant Professor of Instructional Design and Development

Position Description: The College of Lifelong Learning is seeking applications for the position of Assistant Professor of Instructional Design and Development. This is a nine month non-tenure-track position, with the possibility of summer assignments. Consideration will be given for conversion to a tenure-track position.

Responsibilities:

Teach undergraduate and graduate level courses using a variety of instructional strategies and technologies, including online and interactive distance learning techniques. Evening and weekend teaching required. Advise for graduate and undergraduate level courses. Perform professional scholarly activities, including research and proposal development. Serve on department, college, and university committees as assigned. Contribute to the development and implementation of programs, courses, curricula, and strategic plans. Supervise interns and independent study projects. Travel to distance learning sites. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

Ph.D. or equivalent in Instructional Design and Development, Instructional Technology, Curriculum Development, Staff Development/Training, Instructional Systems, or closely related field. A minimum of two years collegiate teaching or training experience is desired. Evidence of knowledge and skills in a wide range of contemporary curriculum and instructional design areas and technologies including: assessment and evaluation; job analysis through system design and evaluation; use of computer and other technologies in performance improvement; and program management of short and long term training programs. Advanced knowledge of instructional design principles, including learning theories, instructional models, and instructional strategies. Wide knowledge of current and long-term trends in higher education. Experience working with instructional technologies in a multi-platform environment. Show evidence of promising research agenda. Established record of scholarly productivity and proven record of external funding or demonstrated potential for scholarly productivity. Exhibit strong leadership skills, understand the essentials of being a team player, and the ability to collaborate effectively with others.
