The successful candidate must have:

- an earned Ph.D or Ed.D. degree from an accredited institution in interdisciplinary studies with emphasis in faith-based leadership or a degree in , philosophy or theology with emphasis in faith-based organization management, faith-based fiscal affairs, not-for-profit organizations, or a closely related field from an accredited institution.
- one or more years of professional work experience in government, criminal justice, and social and political affairs.
- evidence of 18 hours in one or more of the academic disciplines documented on official graduate transcripts.
- taught courses using electronic learning systems for a minimum of two years.
- excellent communication and interpersonal skills that fuse into an existing cohesive team culture
- a minimum of one or two years of teaching experience at a community college or university.
- knowledge of e-learning and be ready to apply it in his/her courses.

Faculty for this degree program are expected to

- Teach undergraduate/graduate classes each semester in one or more of the following disciplines: faith-based leadership, philosophy, theology, faith-based organization management, faith-based fiscal affairs, not-for-profit, or other related disciplines using traditional face-to-face instruction and electronic learning technologies
- Participate in College of Lifelong Learning and University meetings and in-service training.
- Document an active research or professional development agenda.
- Provide evidence of excellence in teaching.
- Assist with marketing and recruiting students for the College.
- Participate in student advisement and committee assignments.
- Travel to distance learning sites to teach classes.
- Present papers at regional and national conferences.
- Supervise independent studies, research projects and internships.
- Teach during the evenings and weekends.
- Assist in program and curriculum development.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
