

Assistant Professor of Interdisciplinary Studies (Emphases in Workforce Communications and Learning Technologies)

The College is a unit for adults who are majors in the Bachelor of Science in Professional Interdisciplinary Studies Degree Program.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate must have:

- an earned Ph.D or Ed.D. degree in interdisciplinary studies with emphasis in Spanish, French, speech, composition/writing, literature, or a degree in English, Communication or related disciplines from an accredited institution.
- evidence of 18 hours in one or more of the academic disciplines documented on official graduate transcripts.
- one or more years of professional work experience in the academic discipline.
- taught courses using electronic learning systems for one or more years.
- a minimum of one or two years of teaching experience at a community college or university.
- knowledge of e-learning systems and the ability to teach online/ or by interactive video courses desired.
- excellent communication and interpersonal skills that fuse into an existing cohesive team culture

Candidates for this faculty position are expected to

- Teach undergraduate/graduate classes each semester in one or more of the following disciplines: Spanish, French, English, speech, composition/writing, literature, or a related discipline using traditional face-to-face instruction and electronic learning technologies
- Participate in College of Lifelong Learning and University meetings and in-service training.
- Document an active research or professional development agenda.
- Provide evidence of excellence in teaching.
- Assist with marketing and recruiting students for the College.
- Participate in student advisement and committee assignments.
- Travel to distance learning sites to teach classes.
- Present papers at regional and national conferences.
- Supervise independent studies research projects and internships.
- Build relationships with the workforce communities for program support.
- Teach during the evenings and weekends.
- Assist in program and curriculum development.
- Other duties as assigned.

Candidates must submit a Jackson State University Faculty Application, submit three letters of references, resume/curriculum vitae, and a sealed transcript from all institutions. Incomplete applications will not be review.
