The Department of Mathematics at Jackson State University invites applications for anticipated tenure-track position at the assistant professor level to begin in the Fall of 2009.

**Qualifications:**

A Ph.D. in Statistics, Mathematics, or Mathematics Education is required. The candidate must also demonstrate excellence in teaching, research, undergraduate and graduate students advising, and service at the departmental, college and university levels. In addition, the successful candidate must demonstrate the potential for success in developing funded programs for the improvement of research and student learning.

**Responsibilities:**

The position involves teaching 12 hours a semester, advising undergraduate and graduate students. The faculty is also expected to engage in research and other scholarly activities. Service on a variety of departmental, college and university wide committees is required of all faculty members.
