# Welcome to JSU Global's English As A Second Language Institute (ESLI)

ESLI provides English language instruction to students interested in gaining a functional command of English in order to prepare for a successful academic or employment experience in the United States and meet the linguistic and cultural challenges of living in an English-speaking environment. Along with quality ESL instruction, ESLI also provides a myriad of cultural activities and events featuring global and local history, art, ethnic legacies, and diversity awareness.

ESLI offers five eight-week sessions per year. The program has five academic levels and accommodates beginners, intermediate and advanced level ESLI students. Classes meet daily for a total of 20 hours per week. ESLI's curriculum consists of both skill-based and content-based courses. Students receive unit-based assessments and on-going monitoring of progress. Each student is assigned an academic adviser and provided tutoring. Students are given a progress report at the end of each session as a guideline for advancement, and awarded a certificate for satisfactory completion of the program.

Applicants must provide the following for the most recent three months:

1. The ESLI application forms, including
  - (1) Application for Admission,
  - (2) Financial Certification, and
  - (3) Statement of Financial Guarantee.
2. A bank statement or a letter on bank stationery stating the required amount to cover the expenses for study;
3. A copy of his or her passport photo page;
4. A copy of his or her immunization records; showing Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccinations;
5. A non-refundable \$50 application fee (pay online via JSU Marketplace)
