## Fall Semester Enrollment Trends 2010-2014 Headcount/F.T.E.

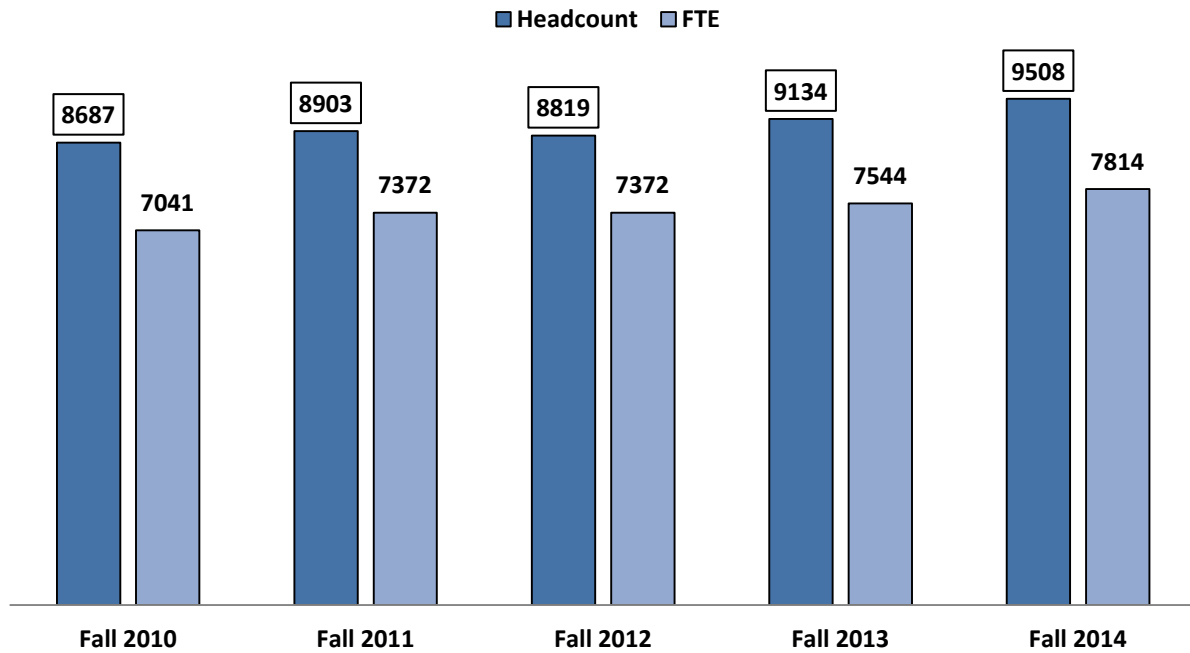
