



State Licensing Examination

Jackson State University's College of Education and Human Development requires students to take a licensure examination to obtain a degree in the Teacher Education Program. This program requires students to take the PRAXIS II examination. Student performance over the past five years is presented in **Table 1** below. It can be seen from this information that the number of students taking the test ranged from a low of 37 in 2014-15 to a high of 60 in 2012-13 and 2013-14. The pass rates ranged from 82% in 2012-13 to 100% in 2011-12 and 2014-15.
