Department of Urban and Regional Planning Jackson State University Application Guidelines for Financial Aid Award

The Department has limited scholarships specifically for financial assistance. This funding is independent from FASFA or any other University scholarships. Applicants who do not meet the deadline in submitting their application will not be considered. Financial aid is awarded based on academic achievement.

In order for students to be eligible to receive financial aid, they must meet the following criteria:

M.A. students may chose from either a <u>tuition waiver</u> or <u>graduate assistantship</u>. Tuition Waiver (TW)-The recipient must commit to enrolling in nine credit hours and maintaining an overall "B" GPA (3.0) for the academic year.

Graduate Assistantship (GA)-The recipient must commit to enrolling in nine credit hours per semester and maintaining an overall "B" GPA (3.0) for the academic year. In addition, the recipient must commit to working in a development agency 20 hours per week. No other employment will be allowed when working as a graduate assistant. M.A. students must have the approval of the Department chair before this is allowed.

Ph.D. students may chose from either a tuition waiver or research assistantship.

Tuition Waiver (TW)-The recipient must commit to enrolling in nine credit hours and maintaining an overall "B" GPA (3.0) for the academic year.

Research Assistantship (**RA**) - The recipient must commit to enrolling in nine credit hours and maintaining an overall "B" GPA (3.0) for the academic year. Also, the student will commit to working with an assigned faculty member and be available 20 hours per week. No other employment will be allowed when working as a research assistant. Ph.D. students must have the approval of the Department chair before this is allowed.

- Applicants must provide an updated official transcript and current copy of your resume. In addition, applicants should submit an essay of no more than 500 words explaining your reason for applying.
- Tuition awards cover only the in-state rate; awards to an out-of-state student will be at the instate rate.
- All awardees must agree to the specified terms and sign an acceptance for from the Department.
