# ASSESSMENT OF CORE COMPETENCIES AND PRACTICE BEHAVIORS BASED ON COMPREHENSIVE EXAMINATION 2014-2015

#### **Overall Examination**

The BSW Comprehensive Examination consists of 123 items. The 123 items are categorized by 14 core competencies. Each competency has a set of practice behaviors. There are 41 practice behaviors in all. Three items measure the 41 practice behaviors. The overall rating of the competency was calculated by averaging the overall percentage of each practice behavior (cumulative % for fall and spring) associated with the competency. The exam was administered to students enrolled in Professional Development. Thirty-three students completed the exam in fall 2014 and 31 students completed the exam in spring 2015.
