FITNESS REQUIREMENT

We do not have minimum or maximum height/weight requirements. There are, however, fitness requirements. Program participants must be in good physical condition to properly wear the uniform and to handle the intense physical training and performing.

 2.7 (cumulative)
- Must have a letter of acceptance from Jackson State University (required for all incoming freshmen and transfer students)
- Headshot (current photo)
- Must turn in all items from the tryout packet by the last day of try-out clinic.
- Previous cheerleading/tumbler and tiger mascot experience (High school level minimum)
- Must have stunting ability/skills
- Tumbling Minimum back handspring (females, Minimum tuck (males)
- Jumps: Toe Touch, Double Toe Touch, and Toe Touch/w Back hand spring, etc.
- Cheer/Chant/Dance Routine taught during clinic
- Attire for clinic:
 - o Female: black sports bra, black spanks or shorts, and a cheer bow. Hair half up/down.
 - Male: Black shorts (no logo), plain white t-shirt,
 - Everyone must wear white cheer shoes.
- Appearance for Tryout Day:
 - Female: look "game-ready," with hair and make-up done as you would for a game.
 Wear a cheer bow with hair in a ponytail (all the way up or half-up/down).
 - No long nails or bright nail polish
 - o Male: Clean white t-shirt, black shorts. You should be clean-shaven and well groomed.

JSU TIGER MASCOT GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum grade point average (G.P.A.) for all full-time currently enrolled JSU students trying out for Mascot is 2.7 (cumulative)
- Must have a letter of acceptance from Jackson State University (required for all incoming freshmen and transfer students)
- Headshot (current photo)
- Must provide black tights and black shorts for performance
- Bring two (2) clean, white T-shirts for performance day
- Performance Guidelines:
 - O Never talk while in uniform
 - O Perform a 2-3 minute routine with props and music (you must provide your own music)
 - o Gesture to game situation questions asked by judges. Show spirit on and off performance area.

CONDUCT

- Candidates are expected to encourage and be supportive of other candidates.
- No food, beverages, or gum are allowed in the facilities other than water bottles.
- No videotaping of tryouts unless instructed by Coach.
- Dispose of any trash and help keep our facilities clean.
- All jewelry must be removed for tryouts and clinics.
- You will not be allowed to leave the mat to go to the restroom. Use the restroom before the clinic starts.
- Give 110% effort at all times.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

- · The use of springboards and mini-tramps are prohibited
- Remember to stretch before and after performance
- Bring athletic tape, braces, wraps, etc. (if applicable)

Note: All candidates must turn in try-out packet items by the last day of try-out clinic no later than 5:30 pm. Male and Female candidates will be judged on separate criteria.

All tumbling must be performed without the use of a spotter.

Cuts can be made during any day of try-out clinic.
