JSU OFFERING FREE MEDICINE DATABASE TRAINING

(JACKSON, Miss.) – A free training on how to use the National Library of Medicine’s health information database will be offered by the Jackson State University Institute of Epidemiology and Health Services Research in collaboration with the Mississippi Urban Research Center.

The training will be held in September at the Jackson Medical Mall in the School of Health Sciences Computer Lab, Room 128A. Adults in the metro Jackson area are eligible to participate and will receive a \$35 incentive after completing the training.

The Web-based four-hour training will include instruction on using the NLM Web site database to retrieve HIV/AIDS education and prevention information.

Morning and afternoon sessions are scheduled on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Registration is from 8-8:30 a.m. for the morning sessions and from 12:30-1 p.m. for the afternoon sessions.

The training sessions are funded by the United Negro College Fund Special Programs/National Library of Medicine, National Institutes of Health.
