- **Mark G. Hardy** of Jackson was recently named dean of the College of Science, Engineering and Technology at Jackson State University. Hardy, a native of Jackson, served as professor and chair of the Department of Biology at Jackson State for eight years before becoming interim dean in 2005. He has worked at Jackson State for 20 years.
