COURSE OBJECTIVE:

To gain a greater understanding of the interplay between the Civil Rights Movement in the 1960s and Labor Movement

Students will research the Civil Rights Movement in the 1960s and the Labor Movement, and then construct a survey research questionnaire or a personal interview (oral history) with elderly relatives and neighbors who worked in the steel mills in Pittsburgh to assess the attitudes of steelworkers towards race and ethnic stratification in the Pittsburgh Steel Industry. Upon completion, the research surveys will be analyzed and discussed in class.
