

# Active Learning Strategy:

**Lightbulb** - a strategy to encourage students to identify any unclear information.



## Goal: Monitor and Assess Understanding

### To Identify Unclear Information

Stop during various points in the lecture or at the end of the lecture. Have students indicate information that is not clear.



#### Face-to-Face

Students can respond by raising their hands when their level of understanding is called or they can write their responses on paper or on a sticky note.



#### Synchronous Online

Students can respond verbally or type their responses in the chat box.



#### Asynchronous Online

Students can type their response on a discussion board or submit it by email.

### To Identify Level of Understanding

Stop during various points in the lecture or at the end of the lecture. Have students indicate their level of clarity— total darkness, flickering, lightbulbs.

#### Face-to-Face



Students can respond by raising their hands when their level of understanding is called or they can write their responses on paper or on a sticky note.

#### Synchronous Online



An online polling tool can be used or students can type their level in the chat box.

#### Asynchronous Online



An online polling tool can be used or students can type their level on a discussion board or in an email.
