## MPA for Non-Accounting Undergraduate Degree Holders

The MPA Program is open to anyone who has a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution. Students with an undergraduate degree with a major in a business discipline other than accounting must complete the undergraduate accounting prerequisite hours listed below before enrolling in graduate accounting courses.

Students with an undergraduate degree other than business or accounting must complete the undergraduate accounting and general business prerequisite hours listed below before enrolling in graduate courses.

## MPA Admission Requirements

The undergraduate grade point average and performance on the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) are the primary items considered in making admission decisions. Applicants should meet one of the following admission criteria:

(Undergraduate GPA x 200) + GMAT Score = 950

OR

(Upper Division

Undergraduate GPA x 200) + GMAT Score = 1000

Three letters of recommendation must also be provided
