

### JSU Key Assessment Consistency Evaluation Form

Compare ratings of each evaluator (rater) on each element assessed. Document the percentage of absolute agreement (all evaluators/raters rated the element the same on the scale) and adjacent agreement (ratings were within 1 scale score). Discuss rationale in case of adjacent agreement on an element of the rubric. Absolute and Adjacent agreement should account for 100% of scores. It is expected that the overall percentage of absolute agreement will be higher than adjacent agreement.



*\*In cases where there is no absolute or adjacent agreement, faculty will be retrained on expectations for that element and/or the rubric element will be reexamined for clarity.*

Consistency (percentage absolute & adjacent agreement) for the entire instrument will be determined by averaging the absolute & adjacent agreement for each indicator assessed.
