ARM 3 Initial Programs

The state of Mississippi has three mandatory assessments that all teacher education candidates must complete, the Teacher Intern Assessment Instrument (TIAI), Professional Dispositions Instrument, and the Impact on Student Learning Assessment (IoSL). The TIAI and Professional dispositions are observational assessments conducted during student teaching designed to assess candidate teaching knowledge, skills, and dispositions. The IoSL assessment is an authentic assessment where candidate's pre-test, design unit plans and assessments, analyze student performance data, modify teaching based on data, and reflect. Each assessment scale ranges from 0 – 3 (exceeds standard).

Data below reflect mean completer performance and range of overall scores on each assessment for the 2023-2024 cohort, as well as, completer's mean GPA (0 – 4.0 scale). Average completer performance lies between 2.0 Meets Standard and 3.0 Exceeds Standard on all assessments. Candidates mean GPA is above 3.0 with GPA's ranging from 2.8 – 3.93.
