## **Overall Performance Patterns**

Across English Language Arts, Math, Science, and End-of-Course (EOC) assessments, JSU EPP completers—both traditional and alternate route—generally trail behind statewide EPP and all-teacher averages in terms of the percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced. However, their average scale scores are often within a few points of statewide counterparts, and a clear upward trend in performance from year 1 to year 3 is visible.

For instance:

- In Grade 3 English (2021–22 first-year traditional completers), JSU had 47.93% of students proficient or advanced, compared to 52.93% (EPP) and 54.60% (all teachers).
- By the third year (2019–20 completers), JSU's proficiency rate slightly improved, although it remained lower (e.g., 32.81% in Grade 3 English vs. 54.60% all teachers).

This pattern persists across most tested areas—particularly pronounced in **middle school Math and English**, where proficiency gaps are larger (e.g., in **Grade 8 Math**, first-year JSU completers had 19.85% proficient vs. 42.42% statewide EPP and 47.03% all teachers).

#### **Contextualizing Lower Proficiency Scores**

While the **proficiency gaps** might initially signal underperformance, it is critical to interpret these results within context:

- JSU completers are **largely employed in critical needs school districts**, where students often enter with lower baseline achievement levels and face systemic challenges (e.g., economic hardship, chronic absenteeism, teacher turnover).
- The data collected measures overall performance, not student growth, which may disadvantage EPP completers working in high-needs environments.
- Despite lower initial proficiency rates, scale scores—a more stable measure of instructional impact—are typically comparable across groups, indicating similar quality of teaching.

#### Year-over-Year Growth and Resilience

A positive finding in the charts is the **upward trend in student performance** over the three years:

- JSU completers' student outcomes show **modest but consistent improvement** by year 2 and 3 in most subjects.
- For example, in **Grade 5 Science**, proficiency rates rose from 42.48% (first-year teachers) to 58.00% (third-year teachers), narrowing the gap with the statewide average of 48.95%.
- Similarly, EOC Biology proficiency grew for JSU alternate route completers from 30.32% in year 1 to 52.41% in year 3, nearly matching statewide all-teacher performance (54.80%).

This suggests that JSU-trained educators gain effectiveness with experience, even when serving in more demanding educational environments.

## **Implications for Program Evaluation**

- JSU's mission to place teachers in underserved schools is being fulfilled, albeit with predictable performance challenges due to student readiness factors.
- Growth trends indicate strong professional learning and resilience among JSU completers, a critical quality for retention and impact in high-needs districts.
- The data supports enhanced training in differentiation and acceleration strategies, which may help close proficiency gaps earlier in the teaching career.

## Conclusion

JSU EPP completers serve where they are most needed—in schools with the greatest challenges. Although their students' proficiency rates often start lower than statewide peers, performance trends suggest these educators improve over time and deliver instruction on par with others when considering scale scores. For a full understanding of their impact, student growth metrics and longitudinal tracking would offer a more equitable assessment of their contribution to Mississippi's most vulnerable learners.

Data for 2023-2024 academic year is currently being collected, and will not be released until late fall 2025 as part of the Mississippi Impact Report Card.
