Educational Leadership (SLLA) Performance

Educational Leadership data show a clear and sustained pattern of improvement over time. Early performance reflected lower mean scores and pass rates compared to the state, but recent years demonstrate substantial gains. By 2024–2025, the EPP mean score is nearly equivalent to the state average, and the pass rate (87.50%) exceeds the statewide rate (85.08%). This upward trajectory indicates that programmatic adjustments—such as targeted test preparation and alignment to standards—have been effective. Overall, Educational Leadership candidates perform competitively and are showing growth.

Psychometry and School Counseling

The Psychometry and School Counseling chart shows a positive academic progression from admission to program completion for both programs, as reflected in candidate GPA trends. Overall, both programs show a **consistent** pattern of GPA improvement or stability, which is a positive indicator of candidate development and program quality. The GPA trends suggest that candidates are academically prepared and are progressing successfully through program requirements.
