## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants must apply to the Division of Graduate Studies and to the Master of Public Health Degree Program in Public Health. Admission into the Program is on a selective basis, with preference given to applicants with a public health related degree, minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), and at least one or more years of public health or related experience.

- Must be admitted by the Division of Graduate Studies at Jackson State University
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Satisfactory performance on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Standard Test (IELST) - International Students Only
- Academic promise as evidenced by above average achievements in undergraduate and graduate studies
- Statement of purpose (philosophy of public health)
- Three recommendation letters/forms (two academic and one professional)
  Letters of Recommendation must be placed on Letterhead
- Resumé
- Immunization Records

Transfer students must meet the same admission standards as all other applicants
