2014-2015 GUIDE TO ACADEMIC ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS

Overview

A limited number of academic scholarship awards are available to students who have demonstrated the potential to successfully matriculate into our Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, and Environmental Engineering programs. **Students pursuing any other major are ineligible for these scholarships.** All scholarship recipients must be continuously enrolled full-time in one of the four aforementioned majors at Jackson State University, and recipients must maintain a minimum GPA of at least 2.75 for continued eligibility. Scholarships are renewable, upon reapplication (based on availability of funds).

Scholarships

- Are restricted for payment of tuition, on campus room and board, and fees.
- Funds are paid directly to the college or university on behalf of the award recipient to be credited to his or her school account.

Eligibility Requirements - Entering Freshmen

- Applicants must have completed high school by Spring 2014 and meet all entrance requirements for the University.
- Minimum high school GPA of 3.00 or higher on a 4.00 grading scale;
- Minimum ACT composite score of 21 or higher (or SAT: 990 critical reading + math);
- Completion of two units of high school algebra, one unit of geometry, and one unit of trigonometry;
- Completion of one unit of chemistry and one unit of high school physics.
- Must apply for financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- Provide a personal statement

Eligibility Requirements – Transfer Students

- · Applicants must meet all entrance requirements for the University.
- Entering Junior/Community College or other transfer students must have a minimum GPA 3.25 on a 4.00 grading
- Preference will be given to applicants who have completed College Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus, Chemistry, and Physics.
- Provide a personal statement

- 3. H.S. students should also submit a letter of recommendation from a member of the high school mathematics or science faculty.

Application Deadlines

- Applicants who plan to enroll in Fall 2014 must file an application by May 15, 2014
- Applicants who plan to enroll in Spring 2015 must file an application by October 15, 2014
