## Admission Requirements

Students applying for admission to the Specialist in Education with a Concentration in Higher Education program must obtain general admission to the Division of Graduate Studies.

Applications are accepted for Spring, Fall and Summer of each year. Admission to the Graduate School does not guarantee admission to the Specialist in Education with a concentration in Higher Education program. All applicants must meet requirements listed below.

- A master's degree from an accredited college or university
- An overall GPA of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale) on the master's degree
- A completed Specialist program application
- Three letters of recommendation
- Acceptable evidence of the applicant's writing ability as determined by a writing assessment completed under the supervision of the screening committee
- A successful interview with the program screening committee
- A recommendation for admission by the screening committee
- A minimum of 6 years of successful employment in a community college or a four year institution
- Deadline for applications for summer/fall admission is March 1.
