### **AREAS OF CONCENTRATION**

#### **Concentration in French**

Twenty-four (24) hours to include: French 101-102 French 201-202 or French 203-213 French 230-231 French 321-322

#### **Concentration in Spanish**

Twenty-four (24) hours to include: Spanish 101-102 Spanish 201-202 or 204 Spanish 230-231 Spanish 321-322

#### **Courses Required for Teacher Certification**

Any twenty-one (21) hours in one language (French or Spanish).

#### **Requirements for a Minor**

In French: 18 hours of any coursework in French. Choose from the following courses: FR 101, FR 102, FR 201, FR 202, FR 230, FR 231, FR 321, and FR 322. In Spanish: 18 hours of any coursework in Spanish. Choose from the following courses: SP 101, SP 102, SP 201, SP 202, SP 230, SP 231, SP 321, and SP 322.
