

EPHD PROGRAM FORMAT


Our program allows you to complete your degree without significant career interruption. It is an accelerated cohort model where you are expected to simultaneously complete with your colleagues within the 24-month program of study. Although the dissertation is finalized in the latter stages of doctoral studies, the preparation, planning and refinement of your dissertation is interwoven throughout the two-year program. Our faculty supports you through personalized guidance and advisement on your dissertation.

MEETING **SCHEDULE**

The Cohort Model residential program meets once a month for three consecutive days on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Hotel check-in occurs on Wednesday with check-out on Saturday or Sunday, based upon distance and mode of travel.

VISITING SCHOLARS, PRACTITIONERS AND EXECUTIVES

Our EPhD Program offers an integration of faculty expertise from academic, executive and practitioner perspectives. Current faculty facilitate the teaching of the academic program of study, and nationally known and prominent scholars are invited to lecture on transdisciplinary topics of present and future relevance in higher education. This combination of faculty and transdisciplinary subject matter provides a unique educational experience.
