

## Financial Aid Checklist

It is important to follow the steps outlined below in order to be considered for federal financial aid and other financial assistance:

1. **Apply** for Admission to Jackson State University through Undergraduate Admissions if applying as an Undergraduate student and with Graduate Admissions if applying as a Graduate student.
2. **Apply** for your **FSA ID** – Before beginning the **FAFSA** process, you should apply for a **FSA ID** at: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). Your **FSA ID** confirms your identity when you access your financial aid information and electronically sign Federal Student Aid documents. If you are providing parent information on the **FAFSA**, one of your parents must also sign your application. To sign electronically, your parent must apply for his or her own **FSA ID** also at: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). **JSU School Code: 002410**
3. **Gather** the Information Required to Apply for **2022-2023 (Fall and Spring)**
  - ✓ Your Driver's License and Social Security Number
  - ✓ Parent(s) Information (Name, Date of Birth, Social Security Number and Marital Status)
  - ✓ W-2 Forms and other records of money earned in 2020 for both You and Your Parent(s)
  - ✓ 2020 Income Tax Return, completed (Even if it has not been filed yet) for both You and Your Parent(s)
  - ✓ Untaxed income records for 2020 for both You and Your Parent(s)
  - ✓ Value of Bank Accounts, Business, Farm and Investments

**Note:** Beginning October 1, 2021, students and their families may complete the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) using their 2020 income and tax information. The 2022-2023 FAFSA will collect income information from one tax year earlier – called “prior-prior year”.

4. **Gather** the Information Required to Apply for **2021-2022 (If Attending Summer School)**
  - ✓ Your Driver's License and Social Security number
  - ✓ Parent(s) Information (Name, Date of Birth, Social Security Number and Marital Status)
  - ✓ W-2 Forms and other records of money earned in 2019 for both You and Your Parent(s)
  - ✓ 2019 Income Tax Return, completed (Even if it has not been filed yet) for both You and Your Parent(s)
  - ✓ Untaxed income records for 2019 for both You and Your Parent(s)

✓ Value of Bank Accounts, Business, Farm and Investments

5. **Complete** Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid at: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). **Priority Deadline: April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.**
6. **Submit** Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid. After you submit your application, make sure you receive a confirmation number. Keep the confirmation number for your record.
7. **Follow Up** on Your FAFSA – If you do not hear from your FAFSA within three weeks of filing, go to [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or call 1-800-433-3243 or 1-800-730-8913 (TTY) for the hearing impaired to check your status.
8. **Apply** for State Aid online at: [www.ihl.state.ms.us/financialaid](http://www.ihl.state.ms.us/financialaid) after January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
9. **Be aware** of the mandatory academic standards required to retain federal financial aid eligibility each year. (See Standards for Academic Progress on our Financial Aid Office website at: <http://www.jsums.edu/financialaid/financial-aid-forms> or in the JSU catalog).
10. **You may** Access Selective Service at: [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov) or 1-847-688-6888 to register and/or obtain confirmation of your registration.

12. **Check** your JSU PAWS Account and Email Accounts (JSU and Personal) frequently for updates on your Financial Aid status.
