I. CALL TO ORDER:

- a. Dr. McClinton called the meeting to order at 1:10 PM

II. OLD BUSINESS

- a. Dr. McClinton mentioned that the two applicants that were tabled from the October meeting have been filed and appropriate responses sent to their department chair.
- b. Dr. McClinton asked for clarity for applicants who are using the old application, since the new application has been online since August 31, 2013. The committee recommended that when the old application is submitted, it should be returned to the department, especially if it is unclear which status the applicant is requesting.
- c. The committee discussed the significance of terminal degrees for applicants. Dr. McClinton reiterated the policy according to SACs. To date several applicants from Social Work and departments in the Liberal Arts have requested graduate faculty status and the applicant does not have a terminal degree in their field of study.

III. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Dr. Dal Didia has been selected as the committee representative for the College of Business.
- b. Dr. McClinton presented twenty-three (23) graduate faculty status applications.
- c. Dr. Dal Didia recommended that the committee consider revising the responsibilities for full and associate graduate faculty because they were the same even as the criteria are different. He will submit an official response to the committee before the next meeting.
- d. The committee concluded that Dr. McClinton can approve adjunct applicants who re-submit incomplete applicants with letters of support.

IV. COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

- a. After the committee reviewed the applications; nine (9) applicants were recommended to the Graduate Council for consideration and approval.
