Probation. Failure to complete the required hours and maintain the above grade point average will result in a [maximum of a] two-semester probationary period, including the current semester (i.e., the next academic semester). Probation is intended to provide a student whose performance is less than fully satisfactory a period of time to bring his/her performance up to a level consistent with the minimum standards enforced by the Graduate School and/or the program in which enrolled. If the deficiencies have not been corrected by the end of this period, the student may become subject to dismissal.

Reason for Probation (check all that apply):

- o Failure to maintain an adequate level of performance (as measured by GPA) in courses central to the student's program of study.
- Failure on the departmental preliminary examinations or failure to stand for such exams in a timely manner.
- o Failure to proceed to the comprehensive or qualifying exams within a reasonable period of time.
- o Failure to make adequate progress in meeting other stated program requirements for example: submission of an acceptable dissertation prospectus, passage of required language examinations, etc.)
- o Failure to make adequate progress in thesis or dissertation research or writing, or in the independent study project.

Students on probationary status may not be admitted to examinations (Master's Comprehensive or Doctoral Qualifying), nor advanced to Candidacy, nor hold an academic appointment, nor receive a graduate fellowship, nor defend a dissertation, thesis or project, nor be eligible to receive a graduate degree.
