In addition to the fine for not wearing a seatbelt, Mississippi courthouses' also impose a \$90.50 assessment fee.

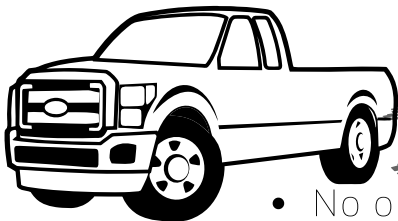
Seat Belt Violations in Mississippi are \$25.00



CHILD SAFETY

- Children up to 7 years of age should be kept in a booster seat until they outgrow the size limits of the booster seats or are big enough to fit properly in seat belts.
- Passengers 12 years and younger **MUST** sit in the rear seat.

 - Anything in the bed of a pick-up truck is considered cargo
