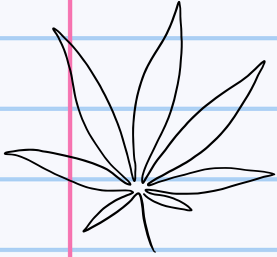


YOUTH ALCOHOL & DRUG EDUCATION PROGRAM

operating a vehicle while under the influence of any intoxicating substance/drug

ALCOHOL IS A DRUG!

ZERO TOLERANCE LAW:

prohibits drivers under the age of 21 to drive after drinking any amount of alcohol

Drive High, Get a DUI

Alcohol is not the only way someone can receive a DUI, It is illegal in all states to operate a motor vehicle while under the influence of any intoxicant.

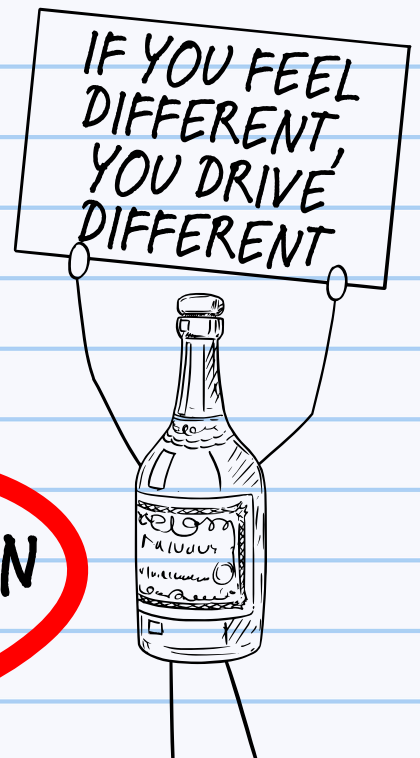


HOW TO PREVENT IMPAIRED DRIVING
