SUMMER SESSION ENROLLMENT TRENDS 1998-2002 (Total Headcount)

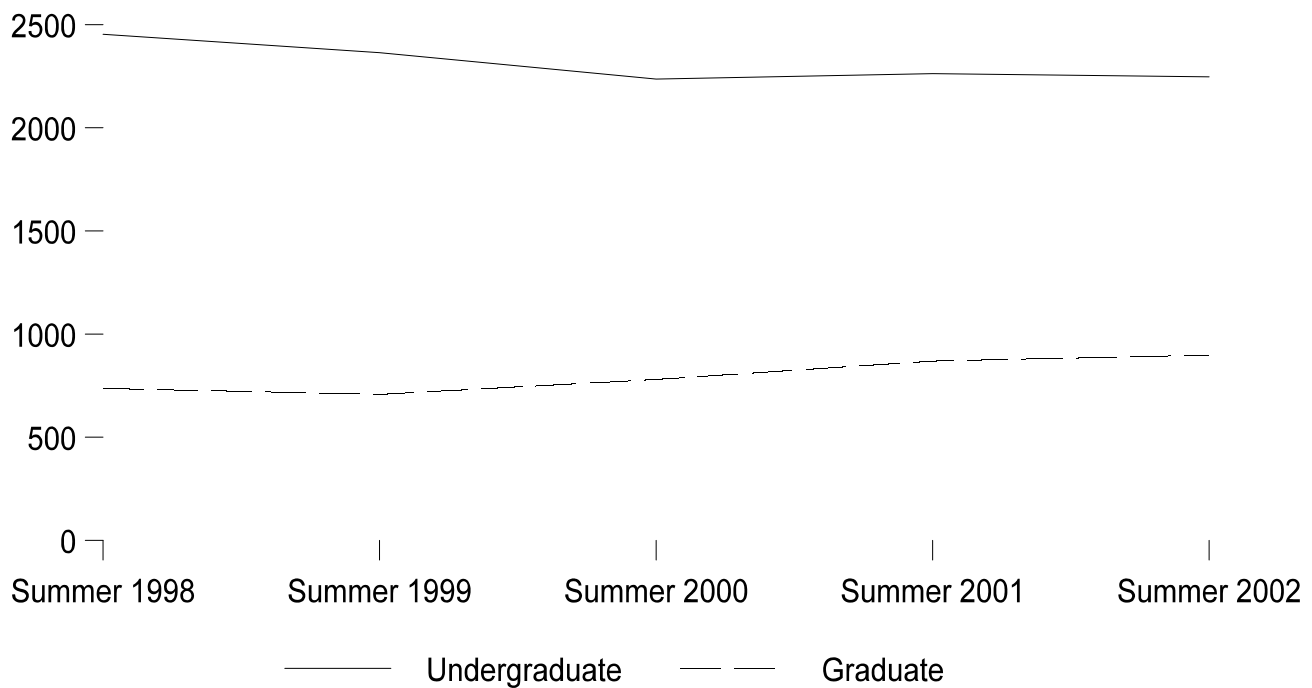
