SUMMER SESSION ENROLLMENT TRENDS 1999-2003 (Total Headcount)

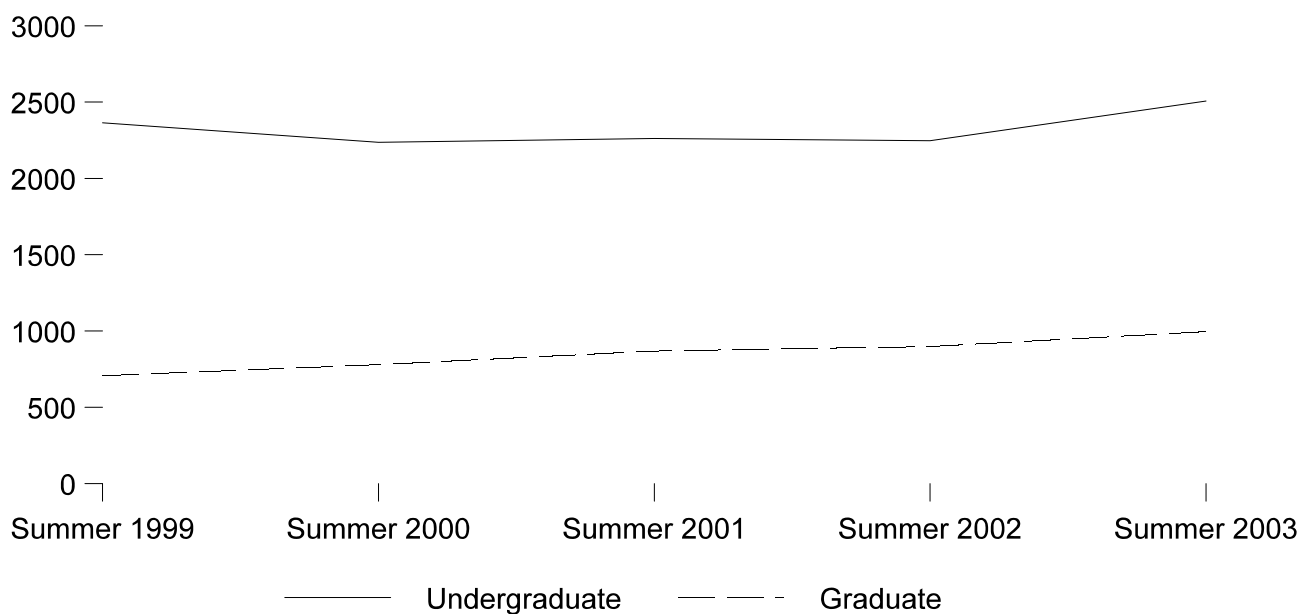
