SPRING SEMESTER ENROLLMENT TRENDS 2000-2004 (Total Headcount/F.T.E.)

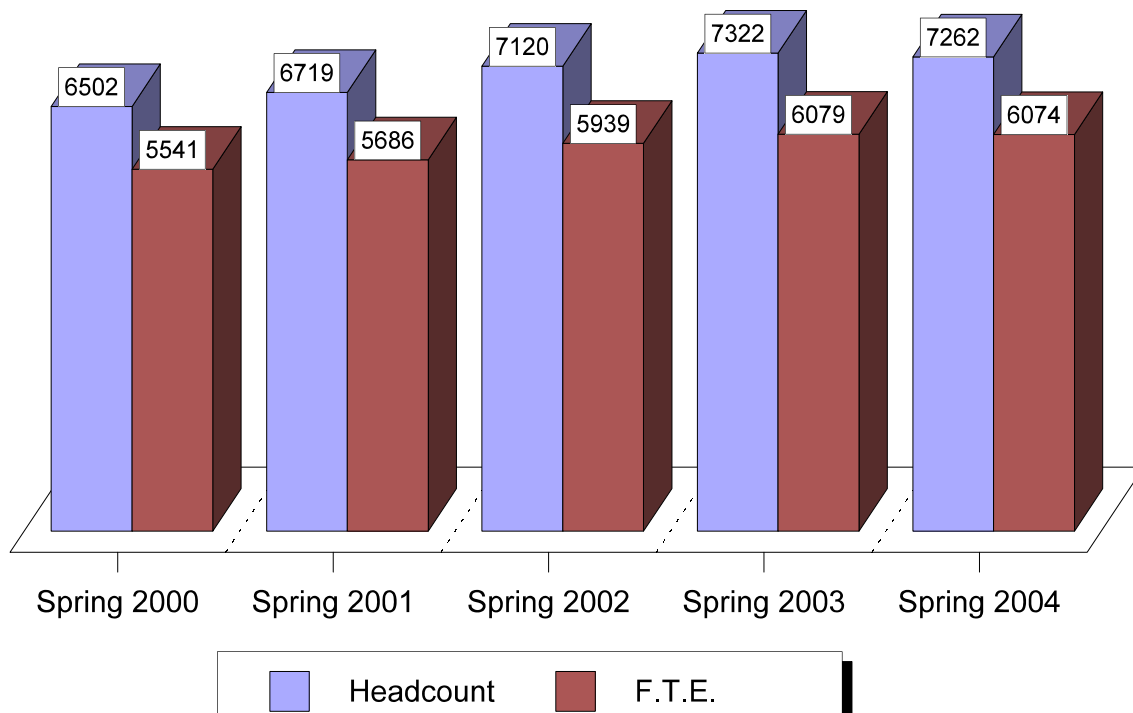
