The Bachelor of University Studies is a degree completion program that provides adult learners with a flexible path to a bachelor's degree. The program is an option for returning students to earn a degree through the Complete 2 Compete (C2C) Initiative. The C2C initiative is a statewide program that was developed to encourage Mississippi adults with some college credit, but no degree, to return to college and finish what they started. The Bachelor of University Studies is appropriate for adult learners who have at least 90 credit hours earned and have not attended a postsecondary institution in the past twenty-four months.
