

DIRECTIONS/PARKING

Take I-55 to Exit 96-A, take ramp (right) onto East Pearl Street toward Downtown Jackson.

Pearl Street becomes the Dr. Robert Smith Parkway.

Turn left onto Dalton Street at the second roundabout.

Visitor Parking is available behind the Jackson State University Student Center. From Dalton Street, turn right into the lot between the Campus Police Station and the Student Center. The parking lot will be in front of you. Stop at the guard station for more information.

AYER HALL



Both a museum and archive open free to the public, the Margaret Walker Center is located in historic Ayer Hall. Built in 1903, Ayer Hall is the oldest building at Jackson State and has been on the National Register of Historic Places since 1977. Sitting at the heart of the JSU campus, Ayer Hall is immediately next door to JSU Library and diagonally across from the JSU Student Center and Administration Tower.
