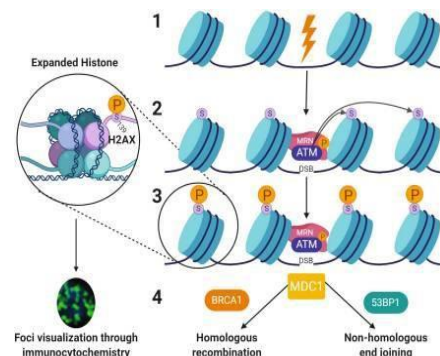
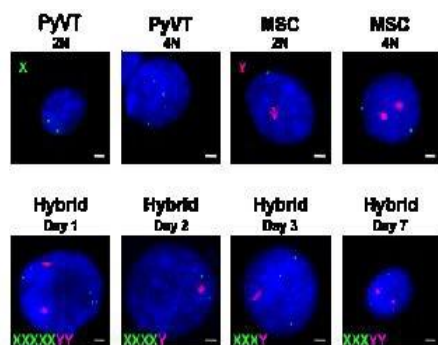


Cancer Biology Lab Assistant
