Bachelor of Music in Music Education (BME) - Instrumental Emphasis

The Bachelor of Music in Music Education major provides each student a curriculum which develops a fundamental skill set in music with specific training in Music Education. Coursework in music begins during the first semester of the freshman year in order that the comprehensive curriculum aligns with the general education requirements during the 4-5 year course of study. Majors should earn passing scores on Praxis I and Praxis II exams and plan their course selections carefully with a departmental advisor. A copy of this plan must be submitted to the main office of the music department and the office of the college advisor by the assigned deadline (see college advisor for precise date) in order to be approved in the Dean's Office.

- 3. Satisfactorily pass the Undergraduate English Proficiency Examination (UEPE) before 60 hours of credit is earned. No exceptions or waivers are granted.
- 4. First-time, first-year students must satisfactorily complete 120 hours of community service as approved by the University. Transfer students (60 or more hours) must satisfactorily complete 60 hours of community service as approved by the University.
- 5. Meet all requirements and apply for Admission to Teacher Education: See Undergraduate Catalog, p. 99
- 6. Meet all requirements and apply for Admission to Student Teaching: See Undergraduate Catalog, p. 99
- 7. Earn a cumulative academic average of not less than 2.50 in all courses.
- 8. Earn a cumulative average of not less than 2.50 in all courses attempted in the major field.
- 9. Take all examinations required by the college and/or department for the student's major.
- 10. An incomplete "I" grade must be satisfied one semester prior to filing an Online Application for Degree
- 11. File an Application for Degree electronically via the Online Graduation Clearance Process schedule.
