- 1. Complete a minimum of 124 semester hours of work
- 2. Satisfactorily complete the curricular requirements in the major field.
- 3. Satisfactorily pass the Undergraduate English Proficiency Examination (UEPE) before 60 hours of credit is earned. No exceptions or waivers are granted.
- 4. First-time, first-year students must satisfactorily complete 120 hours of community service as approved by the University. Transfer students (60 or more hours) must satisfactorily complete 60 hours of community service as approved by the University.
- 5. Earn a cumulative academic average of not less than 2.00 ("C") in all courses.
- 6. Earn a cumulative average of not less than 2.00 ("C") in all courses attempted in the major field.
- 7. Take all examinations required by the college and/or department for the student's major in the 1st semester of earning senior status (by credit hour). If a student fails the departmental exam it must be retaken and results submitted by Feb. 15 (dates for test retake will be established by the departments).
