

Licensure Disclosure for Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) and Master of Social Work (MSW) Programs

Current qualifications for a Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Social Workers and Marriage and Family Therapists, LSW, LMSW, and LCSW licenses are:

LSW Regulations for Mississippi:

Verification of a baccalaureate degree in social work from a college or university accredited by Council on Social Work Education) (CSWE) or Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS);

LMSW Regulations for Mississippi:

Verification of a master's degree from a school of social work accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) or a doctorate in social work (D.S.W. or Ph.D.);

LCSW Regulations for Mississippi:

An applicant for LCSW designation must be a current LMSW in good standing who has completed the Supervision process as outlined in Part 1902, Chapter 2, Rule 2.3 as verified by Board records.

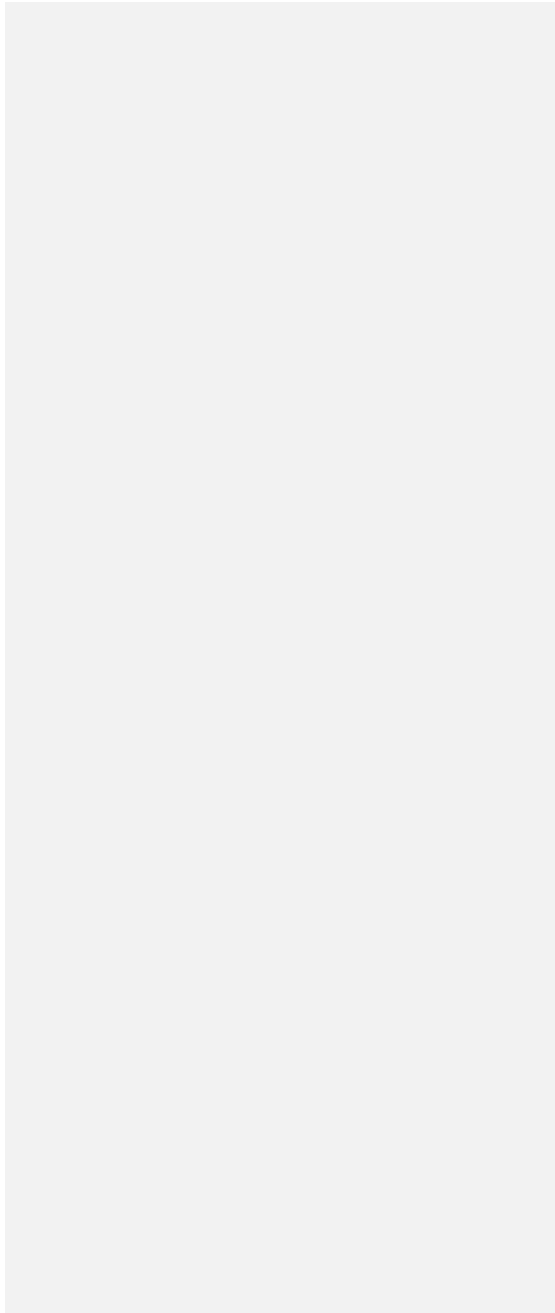
The table below provides:
