Graduate student applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above. Master's applicants must be full-time students in accordance with their discipline's requirements. Undergraduate student applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above. Doctoral applicants are <u>not</u> required to be full-time students. Doctoral applicants must have passed the comprehensive examination <u>and</u> have the dissertation proposal approved by the dissertation committee. Scholarships may be awarded for doctoral dissertation work. A budget request and justification must be submitted by student. First priority will be given to native Mississippians of African-American origin.

The mission of the College of Public Service is to educate students from diverse backgrounds for outstanding professional service and to develop local, national, and international innovative leaders in the professional academic disciplines represented in the Schools of Health Sciences, Policy and Planning, and Social Work.
