Critical Graduation Information:

The following are minimum requirements for all bachelor's degrees awarded by Jackson State University. Some majors and minors require more than the minimum in or more of the areas below.

- 1. Complete a minimum of 124-128 semester hours of work.
- 2. Satisfactorily complete the curricular requirements in the major field.
- 3. Satisfactorily pass the Undergraduate English Proficiency Examination (UEPE) before 60 hours of credit is earned. No exceptions or waivers are granted.
- 4. First-time, first-year students must satisfactorily complete 120 hours of community service as approved by the University. Transfer students must satisfactorily complete 60 hours of community service as approved by the University.
- 5. Earn a cumulative academic average of not less than 2.00 ("C") in all major courses.
- 6. Earn a grade of "C" in all courses attempted in the departmental courses (PS).
- 7. An incomplete "I" grade must be satisfied the next semester after receiving the incomplete grade.
- 8. Complete a degree evaluation the last semester of the junior year and mid-year of the first semester of the senior year.
- 9. File an Application for Degree when cleared by the Chair of the Department electronically via the Online Graduation Clearance Process.

Other Departmental Requirements: Students who are given Foreign Language credit must make up the 6hrs with other courses. Community Service Hours (First-time, first-year-120 hours; transfer-60 hours): *Students who have left the University for a period of time and return to complete degrees will have to report to the Office of Community Service.
